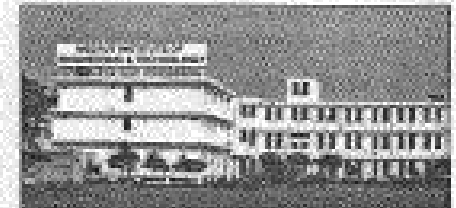
ABOUT THE INSTITUTE

ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

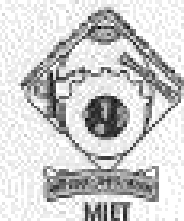

HOW TO REACH MIIT, MEERUT
